The job advertisement is aimed, in particular, at geography teachers at local secondary schools. Employment may take place within the framework of a partial secondment through the *Schulamt* (local education authority).

Job Description:

- Primarily teaching-related responsibilities
- Planning and conducting classes (8 LVS) for all teacher-training degree courses in the field of didactics of geography
- Examination tasks, supervision of students, participation in academic self-administration

Job Requirements:

- First and Second State Examinations for teaching at Gymnasium (secondary schools up to year 12) in the subject Geography with at least good results, as well as teaching experience in lower and upper secondary education
- Very good German and English language skills

Desirable:

- Experience in subject-specific teaching methodology with practical school relevance
