Re: Welcome to your first winter semester at our university!

Dear Students,

On behalf of the Department of Biology, I would like to congratulate you on your admission to the Master's program in Biodiversity, Ecology and Evolution (M.Sc. BEE) at the University of Greifswald.

Clearly with every new start, also here are a couple of decisions to be made prior to the actual semester start such as the choices of elective modules, etc.

During the first two weeks in the first semester, you will have lectures of the obligate 1st basis module, they are planned for the afternoons, so that in the first week you can join the preliminary meetings for the elective modules (usually scheduled in the mornings). Some of the actual lectures of the elective modules will start in the first week, too, but most of them start in the second week. Practical courses are often in block or in the afternoons and usually should not interfere with the 1st basis module.

In the upcoming weeks the University Information System will provide you with the time schedules, depicting the time slots at which preliminary meetings, lectures, seminars and practical courses of the elective modules will take place. If you're planning your courses, please consider that there are lots of possibilities for combinations of the elective modules BUT unfortunately this freedom comes with some disadvantages, too. It's obvious that time and space constraints do not allow the realisation of all combinations. Therefore, it's important for you to plan, and to select the most important courses and potential alternatives for you.

There will be an Excel-File uploaded approx. 3-4 weeks before the semester starts (see please regularly check the link below for updates) in which you will have the opportunity to indicate your priorities for the elective modules. If there are too many students, perhaps only those get the courses, which had set their best (1) (or second best: 2) priorities indicated there. This selection procedure happens each semester, so you will have another chance to set higher priorities to get your desired modules – depending on their availability – in the next semester or year. This selection procedure allows fair admittance to overcrowded/overbooked modules and courses.

I am also up to organise a 1st meeting on Friday, September, 11th at 4:00 pm (16:00, time zone: Berlin) to discuss urgent questions on the study program and module choices. This will be online, so you have not already to be present in Greifswald. The meeting link is the following:

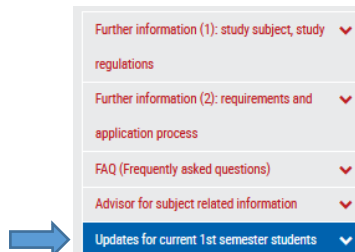
